WITHIN the space of two months last year, Pretoria member Molatelo Malowa published not only a musical album but also a collection of poems. The musical album 'Unjust Laws' was finally released in November 2014 (see August 2014 *Advocate* at p. 24).

It was followed in December of the same year by the poetry collection 'Concise Conscious Column'. The 55 poems consist of 'bad spells and motivation'. It is published by Dinkwe Publishers in Pretoria.

Poems include 'The advocate', 'The bar', 'Bar by far' and pieces about mountain adventures which emanate from a trail walk gone wrong while a group of advocates were at the advocacy training in the Drakensberg in 2011.

Molatelo said that, without the assistance of fellow advocates, it would not have been possible to have two final products.
